February will see us partner with Asia TOPA, Arts Centre Melbourne's triennial festival of performing arts from the Asia Pacific. This year's program includes two wonderful works for families to enjoy. From Nouveau Cirque du Vietnam is À Ő Làng Phố, a dazzling acrobatic circus performance featurina jugalina. balancing, contortion and daring feats. For babies aged 4 - 18 months and their carers comes Flower 꽃, a beautiful trans-cultural dance/theatre piece by Sally Chance Dance (Australia) and Masil Theatre (Korea).

Later in the season we are delighted to present the stage adaptation of the book Charlie and the War Against the Grannies. This musical comedy is created by actor, comedian and children's author Alan Brough (ABC Spicks and Specks). Commissioned by Arts Centre Melbourne, we are proud to host the world premiere of this brand new work for young audiences.Starring Alan himself, this hilarious and playful work combines live music, puppetry and theatre to tell the story of Charlie Duncan and his best friend Hils, two 12 year olds trying to stop a fiendish band of grannies plotting to take over the world.
