
















# From boardroom meetings to cocktails, the Hugh Williamson Room is bold luxury in the Melbourne Arts Precinct.























# Create some theatre inside the velvet grandeur of the Plaza Room.

## 4 Sturt Street, Southbank VIC 3004

Entry to Arts Centre Melbourne's car park is located on the corner of Sturt and Kavanagh Streets, Southbank and is easily accessed from St Kilda Road/Southbank Boulevard (via Kavanagh Street) and Alexandra Avenue/City Road (please note: access from Alexandra Avenue/City Road is only southbound).

Arts Centre Melbourne's car park is open 24 hours a day, seven days a week and offers undercover parking for 800 vehicles. Wheelchair access is available on all levels of the car park.

We offer our event organisers <u>two complimentary day passes</u> with subsequent passes charged at \$17.00 per car per day. For further information please visit our car parking webpage or ask your Event Sales Manager.
